

RESPONSE AND PROTOCOL FOR POSITIVE COVID-19 CASE CHEER HAVEN ALL-STARS

*Haven will adhere to the recommended CDC guidelines for <u>Schools</u> when responding to a confirmed COVID-19 case in the facility.

Confirmed person with COVID-19 in building? Assess Risk Assess Risk Assess Risk Short (potential 2-5 Day) Building Dismissal to Clean/Disinfect/Contact Trace in consultation with local health officials

Any school in any community might need to implement short-term closure procedures regardless of community spread **if an infected person has been in a school building (gym)**. If this happens, CDC recommends the following procedures regardless of the level of community spread:

- Coordinate with local health officials. (North Strabane & Washington County)
- **Dismiss students and most staff for 2-5 days.** (Provide virtual practices via Zoom)
- **Communicate with staff, parents, and students.** (Pre-written email template prepared to inform of exposure; yet the identity of the person who has tested positive for COVID-19 is <u>protected</u> <u>health information</u>, and typically cannot be shared except in select circumstances.)
 - Clean and disinfect thoroughly. (Staff will use recommended products to clean.)
 - Make decisions when to return. Symptom-based strategy. Exclude from school until:
 - ✓ At least 3 days (72 hours) have passed *since recovery* defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications **and** improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); **and**,
 - ✓ At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared
